



An Introduction to Child Protection E-learning Programme Highland Child Protection Committee and the Care and Learning Alliance Voucher Scheme

[The Highland Child Protection Committee \(HCPC\)](#) has purchased vouchers from the **Care and Learning Alliance (CALA)** to enable local practitioners to access online training in relation to Child Protection. This training would normally cost £10 per person and to qualify you must work with children and/or family members in Highland to receive your pre-paid voucher.

Please note, this training is introductory/awareness raising and does not replace attendance at face-to-face training. However, it is a good introduction for practitioners who have contact with children and family members (including adult services). You should always discuss your training needs with your manager/designated child protection person.

To access the material, you must contact the Child Protection Training Team and request a voucher code. You will then be directed to the [CALA learning platform](#) where your code will enable you to complete the e-learning package at no cost to you or your organisation.
