The national guidance supports implementation of the Scottish Government's ambitious expansion of Early Learning and Childcare. The



guidance builds on Pre-Birth to Three and Curriculum for Excellence and provides detailed, practical guidance on the experiences, interactions and environments necessary to deliver high quality learning experiences for babies, toddlers and young children.

The training will consist of a blend of tutor presentation, DVD clips, small and whole group tasks, reflection and discussion.

The day will offer practitioners opportunity to:

- Link the guidance to other national guidance, initiatives and strategies
- Consider the key features of a high quality Early Learning and Childcare environment
- Focus on the nature of development of babies, toddlers and young children
- Consider the adult role in responding to meet children's individual stage, opportunities and methods to support the 'drivers' of learning
