

An cluinn thu na h-èoin? Can you hear the birds?

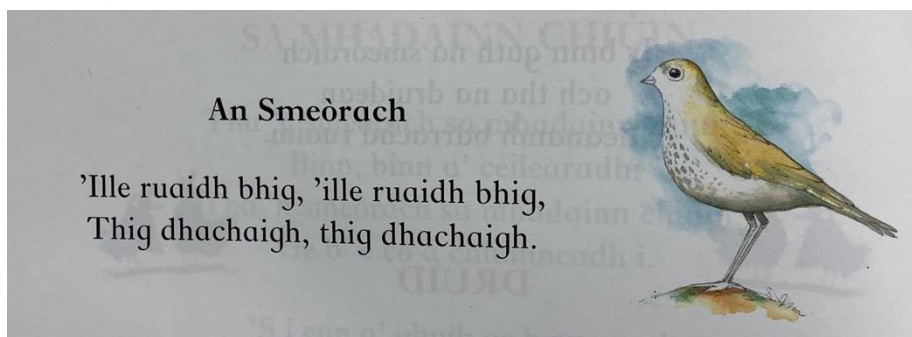
Èist! Cò tha seo, a' seinn gu binn?
