Join the COVID-19 Antibody Survey of education Staff – CASS

Help us understand how many staff in education have had the COVID-19 virus, and how it has affected them, to help Scotland's pandemic response.

The main aim of the COVID-19 Antibody Survey of education Staff (CASS) is to find out what proportion of Scottish education staff have had the COVID-19 virus by testing for antibodies in their blood. This type of test looks at whether someone has been infected in the past.

This study involves completing some survey questions and providing a finger-prick blood sample once a month for antibody testing.

The study is open to any adult who works in a school or early learning and childcare setting in Scotland.

We would like as many people as possible to complete our survey and then request a test through a UK testing scheme. You can get more details on the Public Health Scotland website, where you can then decide to take part or not:
